Barbara Ann Cook, former Senior Financial Assistant, died April 24, 2022, at Stillwater Medical Center in Perry, Oklahoma. She was born January 23, 1957, in Perry to Jimmie and Evelyn (Stout) Spillman. She was her dad's little chicken and most definitely the "wild" one of the Spillman kids. Barbara loved to dance. She competed in a jitterbug contest and was a flag girl her senior year. She was known as Boo to her classmates.

Barbara married Howard Kent Chilcoat on February 14, 1975, at Camp Tan Da Ko in Perry. Immediately following graduation in May 1975, they moved to San Juan, Texas. To this union, daughter Crystal was born in 1976. They moved back to Oklahoma in the early 1980s and later divorced. She met Johnny Dee Cook and they were married on March 14, 1986, in Miami, Oklahoma. Barbara was by his side until his death on October 3, 2017.

Barbara worked fulltime at Charles Machine Works, Inc. in Perry and went back to college part time, earning her A.S. degree from Northern Oklahoma College in 1992. She began working as a Senior Financial Assistant in our department on October 15, 2012, following her daughter **Crystal Gilbreath** who served in that position. Barbara loved bookkeeping and accounting. She began medical leave on May 14, 2018 and was unable to return to work.

She is survived by daughter, Crystal Chilcoat; grandchildren, Brailey and Cannon Gilbreath; and her parents, all from Perry; sister, Marilyn (Bob) Kauffman from Newalla, Oklahoma; and two brothers, Mike Spillman from Bothell, Washington and Bobby (Karen) Spillman from Tucson, Arizona.
