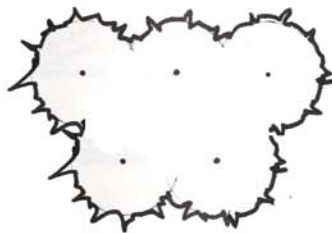
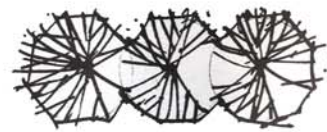
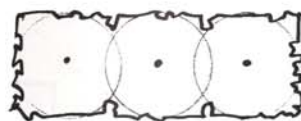
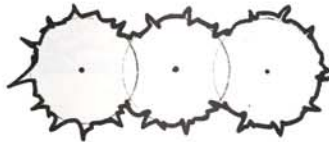
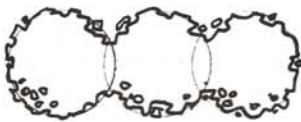
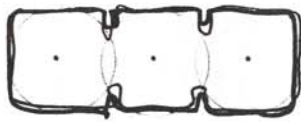
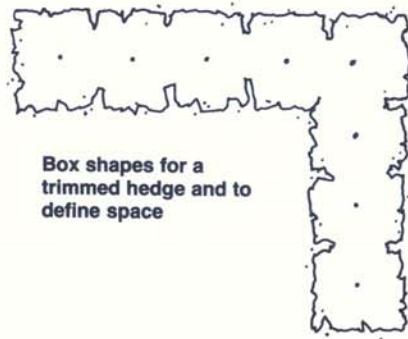


# Shrubs Groupings (5 ft wide shrubs)

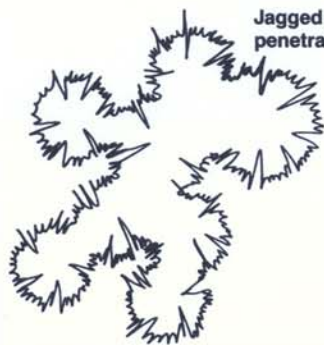
Rounded, smooth edges that show two pen sizes overlapping



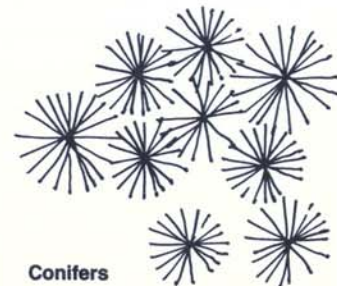
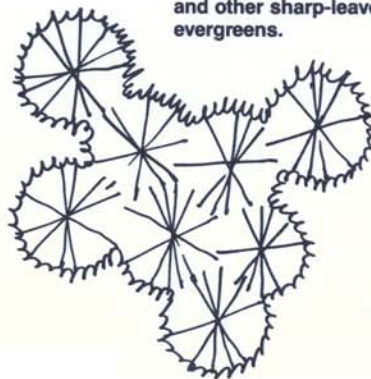
Box shapes for a trimmed hedge and to define space



Jagged strokes penetrating the circle



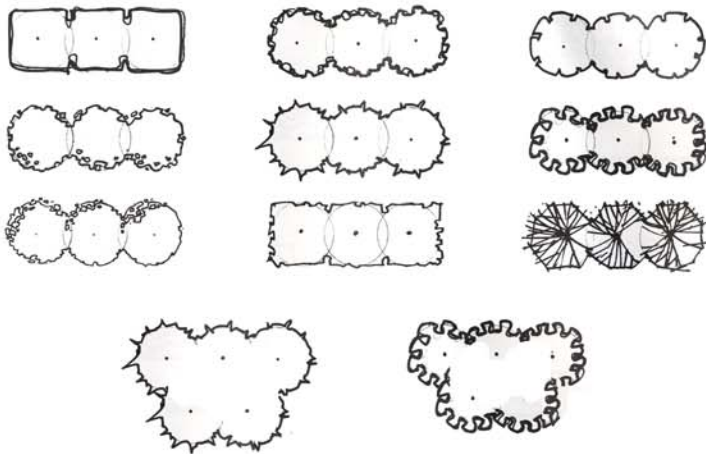
Good for shrubs with needle-like or pointed foliage, such as conifers and other sharp-leaved evergreens.



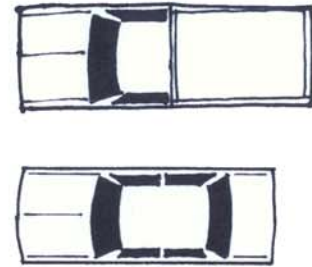

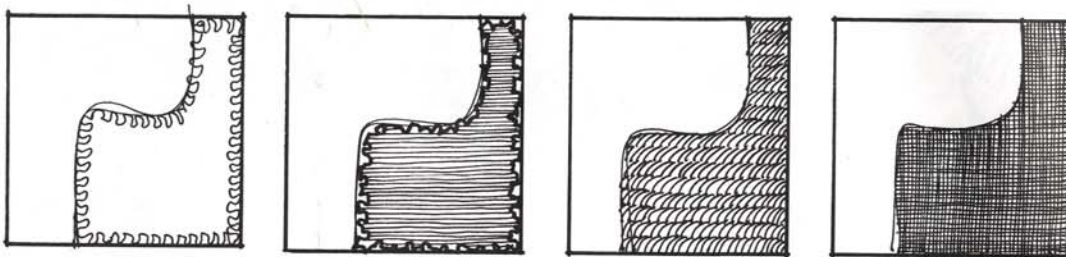

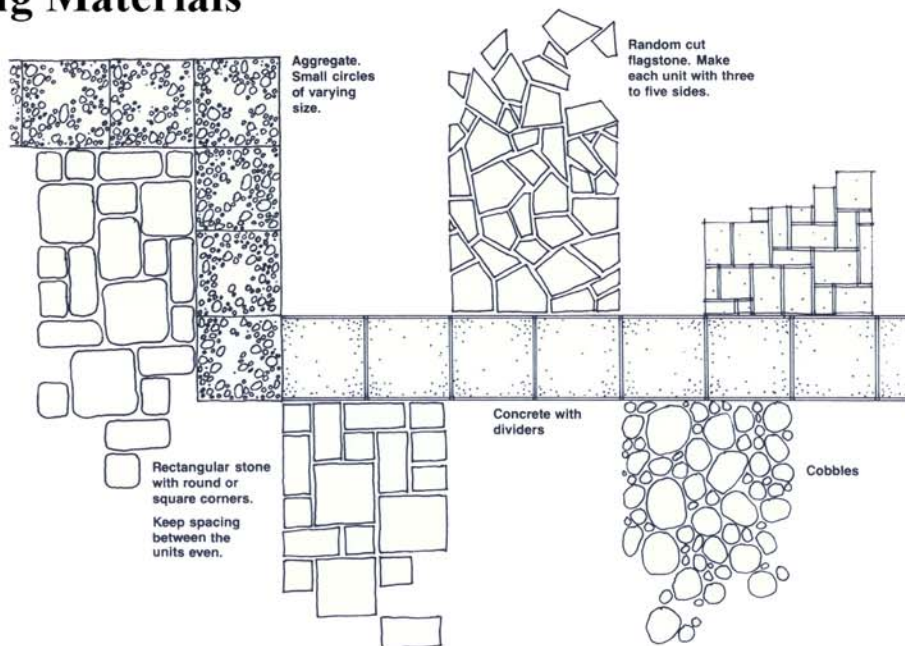
